- Ticks. The tick population has exploded in Ocean Beach this spring and possible solutions to the problem were discussed. The 4-Poster program used in Fair Harbor and Saltaire was discussed, however, JS points out there is no actual evidence of its success, other than anecdotal evidence. In addition, the program is difficult to get up and running and approved every year. In Saltaire they have a station with 3 devices, and the annual budget for corn and pesticide is \$25,000.
 - Action: CG will follow up with Saltaire and post on the OB bulletin board. LL/DJL will do research to determine how effective the program is and research Suffolk County vector control recommendations. LL will post mosquito info to the bulletin board.
