

OCEAN BEACH SUPPORTS THE WRAP PROGRAM

(WE RECYCLE AMERICA PROUDLY)

RECYCLE THESE ITEMS - PLACE TOGETHER IN THE “WRAP” RECYCLE CONTAINER

- Tin and aluminum beverage and food cans
- Glass bottles and jars (without the lids)
- Plastic bottles and containers with the symbol 1 or 2 in the triangular recycling symbol on the bottom of the container (plastic soda and water bottles, plastic milk and juice containers, detergent and shampoo bottles, etc.)

RECYCLE THESE ITEMS – BUNDLE TOGETHER OR SEPARATELY AND PLACE ON TOP OF THE “WRAP” RECYCLE CONTAINER

- Newspapers including inserts
- Magazines
- Corrugated cardboard (ribbed middle layer, usually brown in color), broken down

*It is not necessary to separate or sort glass, cans and plastic items, but do rinse them out and place them loose in your WRAP can for pickup.
Bundle and tie or tape newspapers, magazines and corrugated cardboard into separate stacks and place on top of the WRAP can for pickup.
Don't line the WRAP can with a plastic bag; WRAP materials in plastic bags will not be recycled.*

- Dispose of your used batteries by depositing them in the blue recycling can located near the free air station next to the Post Office.

THESE ITEMS ARE NOT RECYCLABLE

- Plastic bags, aluminum foil, Styrofoam, plastic drinking glasses
- Office paper and mail as well as gift boxes and gift wrap
- Cardboard food, milk or juice cartons, egg cartons, cereal boxes, pizza delivery cartons, plastic fruit and vegetable containers without the number 1 or 2 in the recycling triangle on the bottom of the container
- Clothes hangers, pots, pans, kitchen utensils, metal car parts
- Broken glass, windows, dishes, drinking glasses, eye glasses, ceramics, mirrors
- Toys, buckets, coolers

HANDLING HOUSEHOLD TRASH

- Place household trash in a plastic bag, tie the bag and place in a secured plastic garbage can. Be sure the garbage cans are shut securely to prevent deer and other animals from spilling contents to feed on the garbage.

- Don't use the WRAP can for garbage.

SCHEDULE

- Household trash is picked up on Wednesday and Sunday evenings.
- Recyclables are picked up on Sunday evenings only.
- When holidays occur on Monday, trash and recyclables are picked up on Monday evening instead of Sunday evening.
- When holidays occur on other days of the week, the regular Wednesday and Sunday pickup schedule applies.
- Place garbage cans and WRAP container at the edge of the sidewalk at 7 pm, and return the cans and containers to the property by 10 am the next morning.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Each household is allowed three 32-gallon garbage containers.
- Free pickup is available for the disposal of small appliances, grills, wagons, bicycles and similar items; contact the Village Office to make the necessary arrangements.
- For disposal of appliances and other large items, contact the Village Office to obtain the bulk pickup application and schedule.
- Building and landscaping materials will not be disposed of by the Village. Obtain a list of carting services at the Village Office.
- Homeowners are responsible for providing adequate garbage cans and WRAP containers for rental properties.
- The Stang Corporation is the waste management contractor for the Incorporated Village of Ocean Beach.
